Ohlman Rites Held Tuesday At Winchester

Norbert F. Ohlmann, 54, Lockmaster at Lock 14, Heidelberg, died at 9 a.m. Saturday at his home after suffering a heart attack. He was a native of Louisville, member of the Holy Cross Catholic Church and a graduate of the Holy Cross Catholic School and the Burns Training School, Louisville. He had served as a lockmaster for 15 years.

He was commander of La Societe des 40 Homes et 8 Chevaux Voiture Local No. 1407, a veteran of World War II and a past commander of American Legion Post 79, Irvine.
