## Mrs. Pater, 88, Taken By Death

Mrs. Adele R. Pater, 88, formerly of 318 Washington St. and more recently a patient at the Helton Nursing Home, 819 Buckeye St., died at 12:40 p.m. Wednesday in Mercy Hospital. She had been a resident of Hamilton for more than 80 years.

Born in Covington, Ky. on July 18, 1877, a daughter of Bernard and Caroline Baumann Benzinger, she was educated in St. Benedict School and Mother of God Academy, in Covington.

She was married to John Henry Pater on May 10, 1896, in Covington, and the couple moved to Hamilton shortly after their marriage, establishing their home in the Second Ward. They enjoyed more than 53 years of marriage. Mr. Pater preceded her in death on Oct. 13, 1951.

A member of St. Joseph Church throughout her life in Hamilton, Mrs. Pater was a kind and loving mother and wife, dedicating her life to the welfare and happiness of her family.
