Albert Pater Dies At 67

Albert C. Pater, 67, 2671 Noble Ave., died Monday at 9 a.m. in Mercy Hospital where he had been a patient one day. He had been in ill health and was previously hospitalized.

He was born in Hamilton on Oct. 22, 1903, a son of John Henry and Adele Benzinger Pater and was educated in St. Joseph School.

He was a resident of Second Ward until he moved to Lindenwald 29 years ago.

He married Magdalen Sackerfeim in St. Stephen Church in 1928.

A coremaker for many years, he was employed by the Estate Cove Co. and for the last 15 years, he was employed in the Park Department of the City of Hamilton.

Active In League

Mr. Pater was especially interested in Little League and did a lot of volunteer work in the organization. He also enjoyed working with flowers.

Mr. Pater was a member of St. Joseph Church, the Hamilton Old Timers Club and the International Moulders and Allied Workers Union.
