John H. Pater, Jr., age 83, of 3504 Pleasant Avenue, died at 1:15 p.m. Monday at Community Multi Care Center. He was a lifelong member of this community, born on July 24, 1900, the son of John H. and Adele (Benzinger) Pater. In 1920 he married Anna Steiner in St. Ann Church and she preceded him in 1972. Mr. Pater was a member of St. Ann Church, Holy Name Society, and a former member of the K. of C. He was a molder with the H.P. Deuscher Company in Hamilton and the Peerless Foundry in Cincinnati. He spent the later part of his working career as an assistant manager at Rink's, before retiring in 1969.

Survivors include a son, M. Bernard Pater, Forestville, Md.; four daughters, Aneta J. Andruszka, Portland, Oreg., Ruth M. Muench, Amherst, Mass., and Helen Pater and Lillian Pater, both at home; fourteen grandchildren and eleven great-grandchildren; and a sister, Caroline Cavalaris, Miami, Fla.
