Richard W. Withrow, age 70, of Hamilton, Ohio died Wednesday, July 13, 1994 at 2:57 p.m. in Deaconess Hospital, Cincinnati, Ohio. He was born on May 2, 1924, in Somerville, Ohio, the son of Ernest B. and Elsie (Miller) Withrow. Mr. Withrow was educated in the Hamilton Public Schools and graduated from Hamilton High School in 1946. He served in the United States Marine Corp during World War II.
