Voman killed as train hits car

But where Elizabeth Flesch 22 of 5 Plesant Ridge Ave., was headed is a mystery to her parents.

Miss Flesch was travelling southbound onto the crossing on Kemper Rd., east of Loveland-Medeira Rd., in Symmes Township, O, when the Hamilton County sheriff's deputies.

The train hit the Camaro and knocked it into an embankment.

Miss Flesch died in the emergency room at Bethesda North Hospital at 8:35 p.m., the Hamilton County coroner's office said.

The same train was involved in another collision with two cars; about an hour later in Madeira, and three women were taken to the hospital.

Miss Flesch had been a clerk typ ist in the consumer research department at the Kroger Co. since Oct. 31

She lived with her parents, Richard and Inez Flesch. Flesch is passenger service manager for American/Airlines

"She had friends all over, which is why we don't know where she was going," Flesch, 51, told a reporter this morning at the family's twostory, wood-and-stone residence in the upper-class neighborhood-

"She loved everything-bowling, dancing, a good time.'

Flesch said the family got a call at 9:15 p.m. from the hospital_telling them only that their daughter had been in an accident.
