**Bob Kaelin**, 63, of Park Hills, died Monday in an automobile accident. He owned and was head mechanic of Bob and Harry's Garage in Port Union, Ohio. He was a member of SERTOMA, a Northern Kentucky businessmen's organization, Park Hills City Council and Park Hills Volunteer Fire Department, where he was chief from 1979 to 1985. He was a World War II Navy veteran and was active with the Park Hills Volunteer Life Squad and former president of the Park Hills Civic Association:
