Joe Meyrose, 55, former Post office manager, dies

Three months after the death of his wife, Joseph T. Meyrose, 55, former office manager for The Kentucky Post, died of an apparent heart attack at 2 p.m. Saturday at his home.

Meyrose was a 30-year employe of The Post, leaving his position last summer.

His wife, Lorraine, died of cancer Sept. 3.

Meyrose had no previous heart problems, explained his daughter, Mrs. Audrey Bryant, Cincinnati.

Meyrose, of 18 Pleasant Ridge Ave., Ft. Mitchell, had been kept busy in recent months with various printing jobs, including publishing of all material at Blessed Sacrament Church, Ft. Mitchell, where he was an active member.

He was past grand knight of Father Bealer Council, Knights of Columbus, Erlanger, and member of Bishop Flaget General Assembly, Fourth Degree.

Other survivors: sons Dennis L., Cincinnati; Paul G., Ft. Mitchell; Robert G., at home, and Gerald J. (Jerry) Meyrose, Covington, an employe of The Cincinnati Post; sister Mrs. Mary Jane Dearth, Covington, and a granddaughter Julie Bryant.
