# George Collopy, Democrat leader

GEORGE F. COLLOPY, 78, of 22 W. 33d street, Covington, died 1 p.m. Sunday, St. Elizabeth Hospital, where he had been a patient four weeks.

He had been in the hospital since being involved in an auto accident in the parking lot at Holy Cross High School, Covington, when he received bruises.

He was a prominent Democrat, serving as president of the Kenton County Democratic Club and he also was a Kenton County commissioner for 12 years. Collopy was past president, Holy Name Society, Holy Cross Church.

He was a retired L&N switchman, serving with the railroad 33 years.
