Larry Feldhaus, served Villa Hills as councilman

Lawrence F. "Larry" Feldhaus and his family moved to Villa Hills when it was an emerging community.

"The community was very important to him," said his wife, Virginia "Ginny" Schulte Feldhaus, owner and editor of the Voice of Villa Hills newspaper. "He wanted to help with the growth to make it a city in which everyone wanted to live."

Feldhaus, 65, a three-term city councilman and former member of the planning and zoning commission, died Thursday at St. Elizabeth Medical Center South.

Feldhaus was a past vice president of the Villa Hills Civic Club. He enjoyed woodworking.

He was a retired electrician for Kent Electric Co., Covington; an Army veteran of World War II, serving in the Signal Corps in Germany; and an active member of St. Joseph Church, Crescent Springs.
