Requiem High Mass for George B. Kordenbrock, a machinist at the Decoursey shop of the Louisville & Nashville R. R., will be sung at St. Anthony Church at 9 a. m. Wednesday, following prayers at the John N. Middendorf Sons funeral home, Covington, at 8:30 a. m. Burial will be in Mother of God Cemetery.

Mr. Kordenbrock, who was 53, died Sunday at St. Elizabeth Hospital, where he had been taken after he became ill during services at St. Anthony Church. He made his home on Decoursey pike, R. R. 3, Covington.
