Bernard 'Ben' Meier, railroader 56 years

Bernard J. "Ben" Meier, 93, a 56-year employee of the Louisville & Nashville Railroad, died at 12:10 a.m. Tuesday at his home.

Meier, a machinist for the L & N, retired 28 years ago.

He served overseas with the Army in World War I.

Meier, of 216 Grand Ave., Taylor Mill, was a member of the Holy Name Society of St. Anthony Church, Covington.

He and his wife, former Elizabeth Polking, were married 58 years.
