Willard Schmidt, Priests' Father

Willard Schmidt, 73, of 128 Ross avenue, Bellevue, died at 10 a. m. yesterday in St. Joseph Hospital, Lexington, where he had been nine days.

Mr. Schmidt was the father of two Catholic priests, including Rev. Vincent Schmidt, chaplain at the hospital.

The other priest is Rev. Louis R. Schmidt, Air Force captain and chaplain, Dover, Del. Air Force Base.

Mr. Schmidt retired in 1960 as metal finisher for the Trailmobile Division of Pullman Inc., Cincinnati.

Survivors include four other sons, Charles, Covington, and Willard, Jerry and Paul Schmidt, Bellevue; three daughters, Mrs. Mildred Wildeboer and Misses Rita and Virginia Schmidt, Bellevue.
