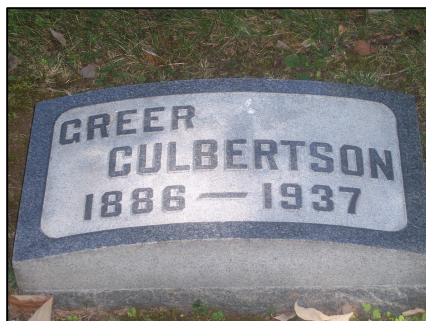


*Culbertson, Greer 1886 - 1937*
