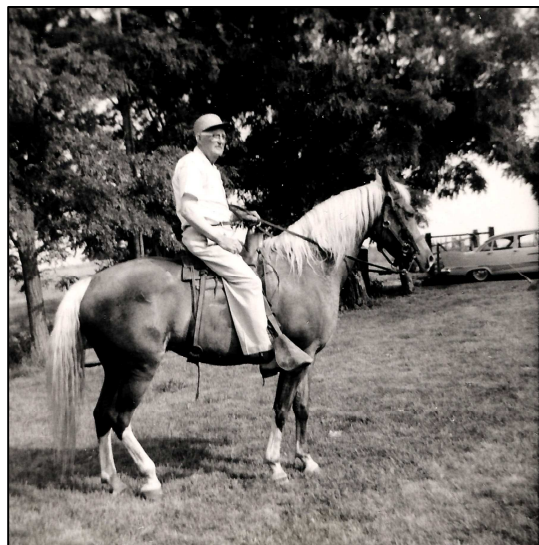

Thomas Jefferson Fuller, 71, Todds Road, died at 8:15 a.m. yesterday at St. Joseph Hospital after a two-month illness.

A native of Bourbon County, he was a son of the late Thomas Jefferson and Martha Ellen Sears Fuller. He was a farmer and an elder of the Old Union Christian Church.

Survivors include his wife, Mrs. Betty Mullen Fuller; three daughters, Mrs. J. A. Barber and Mrs. James Brandenburg, Lexington, and Mrs. William Ruth, Danville; four sons, Julian M. and C. Edward Fuller, Lexington, Thomas U.
