Klosterman Rites To Be Wednesday

Solemn Requiem High Mass for Mrs. Bernadina Kampsen Klosterman, 74, member of a widely-known Covington and Kenton county family, will be sung at 9 a. m. Wednesday at St. Augustine Church, Covington.

Mrs. Klosterman died Saturday at her home, 1833 Jefferson avenue, Covington.

She was the mother of Bernard F. Klosterman, president of the Klosterman Baking Co., Cincinnati, and president of Summit Hills Country Club.

Widow of Bernard Klosterman, who formerly also had been connected with the baking firm, she was a sister-in-law of Msgr. Edward G. Klosterman, pastor of Mother of God Church, and of the late Harry Klosterman, former sheriff of Kenton county and former jailer and postmaster of Covington.

Besides her son, she leaves a brother, Joseph Kampsen; a sister, Miss Rose Kampsen, and three grandsons.

Before the Mass Wednesday, prayers will be said at 8:30 a. m. at the Linneman Funeral Home, Covington, where friends may call from 2 to 9 p. m. Tuesday. Burial will be in Mother of God Cemetery, Covington.
