50 Years in Covington

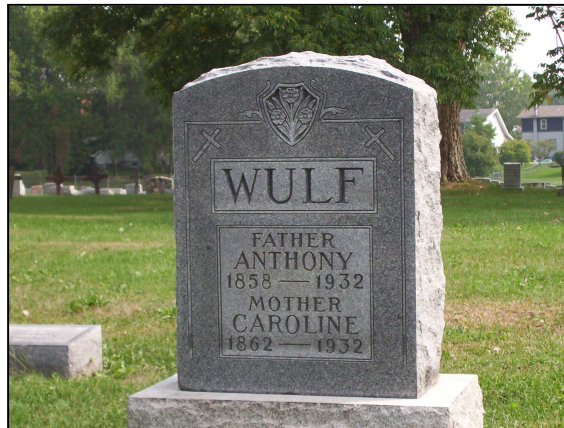
