

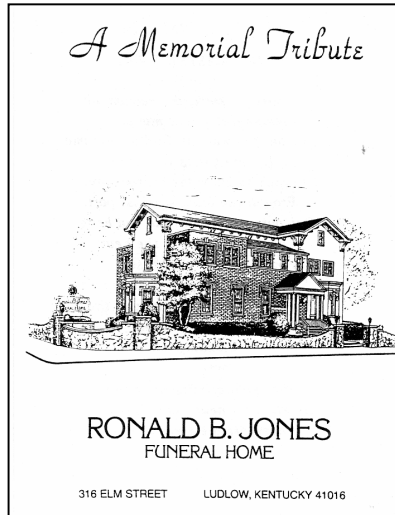
**Kentucky Post – December 4, 1996**
