George Lieland Dies at Hospital

Retired NYC Employee
Was Ill Three Years

George V. Lieland, 69, retired telegrapher for the New York Central Railroad and resident of this city most of his life died at Major Hospital Sunday at 7:35 p. m. following a three-year illness.

Mr. Lieland, whose home was at 1119 Meridian St., was born at Prescott May 8, 1888, the son of Bernard and Mary (Goebel) Lieland. He was a member of the St. Joseph Catholic Church, the Holy Name Society and the Order of Railway Telegraphers.

On October 22, 1913, he was married to Irene Zinser who survives with three children, Mrs. Arlene Caron of this city, Mrs. Verne Grace Soller of Starkville, Miss., and Melvin Lieland of Rushville. There are eight grandchildren and also surviving are three sisters and two brothers, Mrs. Clara Bauer, Mrs. Ann Furry, Miss Helen Lieland and J. E. Lieland, all of Indianapolis, and Bernard Lieland of Detroit, Mich. Two brothers preceded in death.
