PLAN FUNERAL FOR LUX YOUTH

Last Rites for Accident Victim to Be Held Saturday

Funeral services for Marshall Lux, age 17, who was killed Wednesday night as a roadster in which nine boys were riding struck a horse in a country road, will be held at the St. Vincent Catholic church at 10 a. m. Saturday, with the Rev. Bernard H. Reidford, pastor of the church, officiating. Burial will be in the church cemetery in charge of Ralph J. Edwards, funeral director.

Young Lux's death was the ninth attributed to traffic in Shelby county during 1938. The deceased was widely known as a junior corn exhibitor and was the son of Ed N. Lux, former international corn king.
