George Francis Lux, 77, R.R. 1, Waldron, died Tuesday at 4:35 p.m. at Methodist Hospital in Indianapolis.

A lifelong resident of Shelby County, Mr. Lux was a retired farmer and a member of St. Vincent Catholic Church.

He was a U.S. Army veteran of World War II and received the Bronze Star and five operations ribbons.

Born on Dec. 15, 1913, in Shelby County, he was a son of Edward N. and Henrietta (Leland) Lux.

Survivors include a sister, Betty M. Lux, Waldron; brothers, Virgil E. Lux and Victor C. Lux, Shelby County, and Leland P. Lux, Arlington, Texas.

He was preceded in death by a son.
