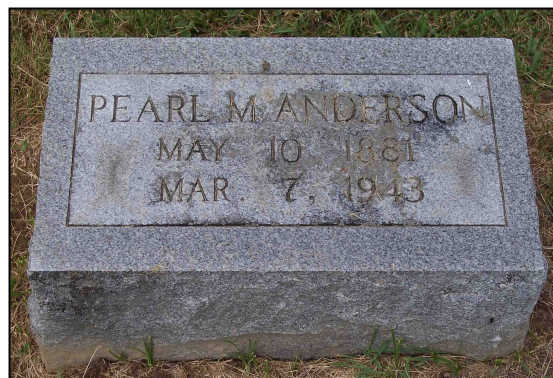


Anderson, Sarah Pearl Mullen 1880 - 1943

MRS. PEARL ANDERSON

Mrs. Sarah Pearl Anderson, 63 years old, widow of Shirley Anderson, died Sunday, March 7, at her home in Leesburg after an extended illness. She was born May 10, 1880, in this county, a daughter of the late J. Monroe and Kitty Ann Whalen Mullen. In 1900 she married Mr. Anderson and he died March 10, 1931. She is survived by two daughters, Mrs. Arthur Dunn, this county, Mrs. J. Allen Monson, Greensburg; four sisters, and a brother, Mrs. J. L. Johnson, Lexington; Mrs. James Kearns, Cynthiana; Mrs. Sanford Hill, Hamilton, Ohio; Mrs. Wm. Elliott and Henry Mullin, Rushville, Ind.; two half brothers, Zeke and Richard Mullin, Bourbon county and Albert Mullin, Boyd. Mrs. Anderson had spent all of her busy life in the neighborhood in which she died where she had a host of friends who regret to learn of her passing. Funeral services were held Tuesday afternoon at 2:30 o'clock at Leesburg Christian church, with the Rev. George W. Boswell, officiating. Burial in Jacksonville cemetery. Pall bearers, Stewart Shrapshire, T. Rowland, Felix Skinner, J. M. Brock, Ray Paul, and James Conner. Mrs. Anderson was a staunch member of the Christian church at Leesburg, joining when 14 years of age.
