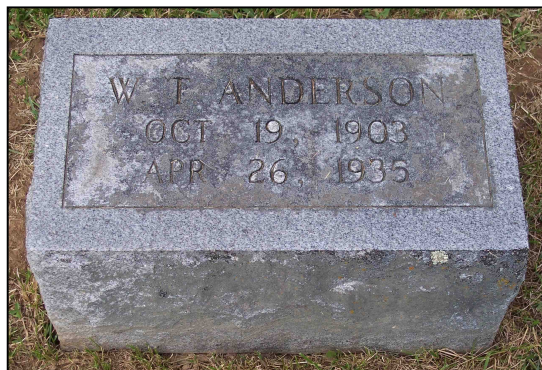


Anderson, William Thomas 1903 - 1935

ANDERSON—William Thomas Anderson, 32 years old, died Friday, April 26, 1935, at his home at Leesburg, after an illness of six months. He was born in this county, October 19, 1903, a son of Mrs. Pearl Mullen Anderson and the late Shirley Anderson.
