SARAH MULLEN ARNOLD

Mrs. Sarah Cam Mullen Arnold, 81 years old, widow of Joe Arnold, passed to her reward last Thursday afternoon, August 22, at her home in Parkland Heights, this city. She was the daughter of the late Nelson and Nancy Juett Mullen and was born April 26, 1859, near Curry, this county. To her relatives and friends, she was familiarly known as "Sissy". On October 23, 1882, she was united in marriage to Joe Arnold, well known livestock trader and farmer. They began their home in the Avena community where their four children were born and where they were held in high esteem by all who knew them. Seventeen years ago they moved from the farm to their home in Parkland Heights where they received their relatives and friends in genuine southern hospitality and engaged in quiet and restful conversation. Mr. Arnold passed to his reward seven years ago and since that time Mrs. Arnold had continued to maintain the home. Mrs. Arnold is survived by three of her four children, (a son, Fred having passed on thirty-five years ago), Harry Arnold of this city, Mrs. Desha Whitaker of Sunrise and Wood Arnold, of the Avena community. She is also survived by fifteen grandchildren and two nephews, Claude and Joe Mullen of this county. Mrs. Arnold was truly one of the old stock. Her manner was quiet, but her convictions were firm. Her most outstanding characteristic was the charitable attitude which she maintained toward other people. As a wife and mother she was unexcelled. As a neighbor she won the love of all who came in contact with her. At the age of fourteen she united with the Curry M. E. Church South where her membership remained until the time of her death. In her religious experience she gained certain firm and assuring convictions which served to sustain her until the end and only a very short time before her passing she gave assurance to her family that all was well with her. In her last illness which lasted only a week, she was a most patient sufferer. The funeral service was held on Saturday afternoon at the late residence, conducted by Dr. W. P. Fryman, assisted by Rev. C. G. Dearing and Rev. E. Keevil Judy. The casket bearers were her grandsons: Fred Desha Whitaker, Benjamin Rees Whitaker, Louis Russell Whitaker, Nelson Keevil Whitaker, McElwin Whitaker, and Woodrow Arnold. Honorary bearers were six granddaughters: Joella Whitaker Bramel, Ruth Whitaker, Eureka Whitaker, Dorothy Arnold, Louise Arnold, and Nancy Arnold. The body was laid to rest in Battle Grove cemetery in the midst of a profusion of flowers and in the presence of a great host of friends and relatives.—Contributed.
