operated by Jess Hayes 428 Main Hamilton.
The drivers and Earl Schwab age 42 who was
riding with Brannon escaped unhurt. The
accident was investigated by Deputy Sheriffs
Charles Walke and Mark Duerr. Both cars
according to the officers were badly wrecked."
