Raymond Doane

Raymond Doane, 54, Frog-town road, R. 2, Walton, was found dead of a .12-gauge shotgun wound at 2:45 p. m.

Sunday at his home.

Jerry Rouse, Boone County coroner, said the wound was self-inflicted. He said Mr. Doane, a farmer and bachelor, who lived alone, placed the double-barreled weapon in his mouth and pulled the trigger.

An acquaintance, Buford Taulbee, discovered the body, Rouse said.

SURVIVORS include three brothers, Robert and Russell, Union, and William C. Doane, Frankfort, and three sisters, Mrs. Ruby Fisk, Florence; Mrs. Bernice Hedges, Union, and Mrs. Nelle Collette, Covington.
