Carrie Elliott Dies In Ohio

Mrs. Carrie Elliott, 77, of Rushville died at 2 p.m. Monday at the home of a son, Frank Elliott, in Milford, O., where she had been staying since January 15, after several years of failing health.

She was born in Beattyville, Ky., on August 11, 1887, the daughter of Jerdon and Kitty Mullin, and came to the Rushville community in 1914. Her husband, William Elliott, Sr., died in August of 1946.

Mrs. Elliott was a member of the Church of God.

Surviving with the son, Frank, at whose home she died, are three other sons, Ray Elliott of Rushville and Guss and William Elliott, Jr., both of Muncie; two daughters, Mrs. Clifford (Elizabeth) Williamson of Muncie and Mrs. Wilbur (Mary Frances) Gatewood of Carthage; two sisters, Mrs. Elizabeth Hill of Hamilton, O., and Mrs. Martha Johnson of Georgetown, Ky., 17 grandchildren and 11 great-grandchildren.

Two sons, Homer and Walker Elliott, and three brothers preceded her in death.
