Mrs. Martha D. Hill, whose death on Nov. 6 was recorded in last week's paper, died after an illness of eight days of bronchial pneumonia, following influenza. She was born on March 31, 1877 and was the daughter of Thomas and Nancy Dunn, deceased. Twenty-two years ago she married Mr. Ches Hill, who survives with five children, John Parker Hill, Mrs. Artie Hill, Eugene, Willard and Mildred Hill, also ten brothers and sisters, Mr. Frank Dunn, of Illinois; Aaron Dunn, of Cincinnati; Mrs. Zella Warner, of Berry; Mrs. Fannie Ecklar, of Kelat; Atwell Dunn and Mrs. Lizzie Griffin, of Cynthiana; Mr. Ed. Dunn, Mrs. Addie Toadvine, Mrs. Kate Ecklar, of Millersburg; Mrs. Lucius Hill, of Headquarters; also six half-brothers and sisters, John Martin, of Lair; Albert Martin, of Kelat; Mrs. Press Karrack, of Cynthiana; John and Park Dunn, of Illinois; and Morgan Dunn, of Oklahoma.

She was a member of Curry M. E. Church and a good Christian wife and mother and an excellent neighbor. The funeral services were held at Curry Cemetery, Friday, Nov 8, after which her body was laid to rest in the family lot by the side of her two little daughters, Edna and Lucile, who died several years ago.
