## Sanford M. Hill Succumbs At 81

Sanford McDonald Hill, 81, 1343 High St., a resident of Hamilton for more than 50 years, died of complications Thursday at 9:15 a. m. in the Sunnybreeze Convalescent Home, 350 Hancock Ave., where he had been a patient for four months.

He was born in Cynthiana, Ky., on July 15, 1876, son of John and Sarah Thorpe Hill. A machinist, he was employed by Champion his entire working life. He retired four years ago.

Mr. Hill was a member of the High St. Christian Church, Butler Aerie 407 Fraternal Order of Eagles and was a woodworking hobbyist. He married Elizabeth Mullen on June 12, 1899.
