Mrs. Martha Turner Holland, 67, wife of Charles Franklin Holland Sr., died at 3:30 a. m. Monday, March 31, 1947, at her home on the Republican Pike in Harrison County. Mrs. Holland had been in ill health for three years, and for the past six months her condition had been serious.

A native and lifelong resident of Harrison County, Mrs. Holland was born Feb. 16, 1880. She was a daughter of the late Pierce and Sarah Ellen Prows Turner. She was married to Mr. Holland Feb. 24, 1899, and she had been a member of the Lower Curry Methodist Church since she was about 16 years of age.

Besides her husband, she is survived by two daughters, Mrs. Lorie E. Lowe of Cynthiana and Mrs. Frank Rice of Covington; four sons, James Stanley Holland of Harrison County, Roy Holland of Cynthiana, Ray and Charles F. Holland Jr., of Covington; three sisters, Mrs. Keller Ashbrook of Harrison County, Mrs. Albert Layhart of Cynthiana, and Mrs. Ed Clifford of Lexington; and two brothers, Martin Turner of Harrison County and Harry B. Scott of Chicago.

Funeral services were held Wednesday afternoon at the Whaley Funeral Home. Rev. Frank C. King officiated. Burial was in Battle Grove Cemetery. Pallbearers selected were Irvis Turner, Stanley Lemons, John B. Lowe, Will Massie, Waits Gorham and John Dunn.
