

**Fall From Roof
Is Fatal To
R. C. Johnson.**

Russell Carlton Johnson, 48, of 427 East Seventh Street, died at 3:05 p.m. Thursday at Good Samaritan Hospital. He suffered a skull fracture a short time earlier in a fall from a roof at 232 Oldham Avenue.

Mr. Johnson, a carpenter, was with a crew of men trimming a tree when the accident happened. He was a native of Scott County, a son of Mrs. Martha Ellen Mullen Johnson and the late Joe Lee Johnson. He was a member of Gilead Methodist Church, Scott County.
