Mrs. Mary E. Mullin, 87 years old, widow of John N. Mullin, died Friday, January 29, at the nursing home of Mrs. Harry Day, on South Main street. She had been in failing health for the past several years but her death was unexpected and came as a shock to her many relatives and friends.
