MULLEN— Mrs. Sarah Elizabeth Mullen, wife of George Mullen, died at their home on South Main street at 7 o'clock Sunday morning, Nov. 24, from cerebral hemorrhage, after an illness of a few hours. Mrs. Mullen was in apparently her usual health the evening before and assisted in entertaining some friends at a dinner party at her home. She was stricken at about three o'clock Sunday morning, and lingered unconscious till the end. Her death was a great shock to her devoted family and friends. Mrs. Mullen was born in this county April 4, 1850, a daughter of the late Mr. and Mrs. John A. Daniel. She became the wife of Mr. Mullen in 1867. She was a woman of lovely disposition, kind and gentle, with a good word for everybody and an unkind thought for none. She was devoted to her husband and family and found her greatest delight in her home. She was a member of the Methodist church of long standing. Mrs. Mullen is survived by her husband, two daughters and two sons, Mrs. R. E. Fennell, Mrs. O. C. Kendall, Luther Mullen, of this city, and Will Mullen, of Huntington, W. Va. Also by two sisters and a brother, Mrs. Anna Hill, Mrs. May Florence and John Daniel, all of this county. The burial took place in Battle Ground cemetery Tuesday afternoon, with services at the grave by Rev. J. P. Strother. The pallbearers were, Wm. Florence, Thos. Hill, S. F. Sprake, Chas. Fitzwater, J. E. Gruelle, C. M. Jewett.
