

Mullin, Dixie 1925 - 2007

Dixie Mullin, 81, South Bend, died Friday, Feb. 9, 2007 at Memorial Hospital in South Bend. Born April 7, 1925 in Cynthia, Kentucky, he was the son of the late Henry S. and Virginia (McKinley) Mullin. He married Joan Ruby September 3, 1950 in Rushville and she survives.

Mr. Mullin was a graduate of the University of Kentucky and a World War II army veteran. He managed several Marsh Supermarkets in the Rushville, Anderson and Elwood areas until 1964, and was a resident of South Bend from 1964 until the time of his death.

Survivors, along with his wife of 56 years, include four daughters, Marsha Mullin, Nashville, Tenn., Christine Magallo'n, Greenfield, Calif., Karen Mullin, Louisville, Ky., and Margaret (T.J.
