William Robert Turner, 63, died Sunday, June 20, at 6:45 p. m. at the Harrison Memorial Hospital.

Born Oct. 29, 1901, in Harrison County, he was the son of the late Godfrey and Bessie Kearns Turner. Employed as a barber at the Smith Barber Shop in Cynthiana he was a member of the Mt. Pleasant Methodist Church and the Elks and Odd Fellows Lodges.

Mr. Turner returned to Harrison County in 1951 after living in Bowling Green for the previous 24 years.
