## James Wainscott dies suddenly

James Edward Wainscott, 59, Georgetown, died suddenly Sunday afternoon at his home from an apparent heart attack.

He was a native of Scott County, son of Stella Perkins Wainscott, Georgetown, and the late Denver Wainscott. He was a retired building contractor and a member of Gano Avenue Baptist Church. He was a veteran of World War II, having served four years in the Pacific Theater and was the recipient of the Bronze Star.
