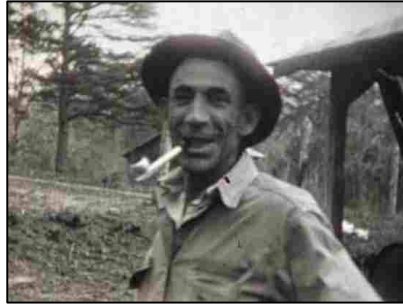


Brown, William Newton 1906 - 1968
