Rites Tuesday For Deputy Sheriff Ransdell

Funeral services for Chester M. Ransdell, 56, a Bourbon County deputy sheriff and a candidate for county jailer will be held at 2 p.m. Tuesday at the Karl K. Lusk and Son Funeral Chapel, with the Rev. Robert B. Wallace officiating. Burial will be in the Paris Cemetery.

Casket bearers will be Fred Boling, Eugene Flora, Norman Allen, Alvin Pridemore, Charles Ransdell, Harry Ransdell, James Sageser and J.C. Fuller.

Deputy Ransdell died at 7:10 a.m. Saturday at his home at 1902 Rio Vista Drive of an apparent heart attack.

He had been a member of the Paris police force and had operated a restaurant here prior to becoming a deputy sheriff.
