Harry Lee Willoughby Sr., 50, Route 1, Georgetown, was drowned shortly after 2 p. m. Sunday while fishing in the Kentucky River in a home-made aluminum fishing boat. The accident occurred at a remote spot on the river near the end of Dry Branch Road in Fayette County.

Services were conducted Tuesday at 3:00 p. m. at the Tucker Funeral Home. Burial was in the Georgetown Cemetery.

Willoughby's survivors include his wife, Dorothy Sears Willoughby; two sons, Harry Lee Jr., and Thomas Ray; a daughter, Barbara Ann; his mother, Annie Tubbs Willoughby, all of Scott County; four sisters, Mrs. Powell Moore, Paris; Mrs. James Florence, and Misses Veima and Mae Willoughby, all of Scott County, and two brothers, Arnold and Carl, both of Scott County.
