William Westly "Wes" Lillie, 61, of Louisville, died Sunday at Hospice and Palliative Care of Louisville's Inpatient unit Norton Audubon Hospital.

He was a member of Cavalier A-Club since 1960, the St. George Ball Club from (1960-1976), a

graduate of Flager High School in 1959, and founder and president of the old WIP Imports. Wes was a member of the Kentuckiana Football Association for 24 years (1957-1980), a former president of KFOA (1955), a KFOA board member for three years, the Sam Grunelsen Award recipient in 1986, inducted in the KFOA Hall of Fame in 1993, supervisor of officials through (1991-1993), KHFAA, assistant secretary from (1999-2002), a member of Woodhaven Country Club and an avid Kentucky Wildcat Fan.
