Mail Employe Dies At Wheel of Truck

Requiem High Mass for Charles Toebbe, 40, an employe of the Covington Postoffice, who collapsed and died at the wheel of a mail delivery truck Thursday, will be sung at 9 a. m. Monday at St. Augustine Church, following prayers at 8:30 a. m. at the Middendorf funeral home, 917 Main street, Covington. Burial will be in Mother of God Cemetery.

Mrs. Tressa Riffe, Kenton county coroner, said Mr. Toebbe died of a heart attack.

Kenton county police said his daughter, Lucille, 12, was riding with him when he was stricken while driving on the Dixie Highway at Kyles lane. They said the girl told them her father suddenly slowed the truck and pulled over to the side of the road and placed his hands to his head. She said she pulled on the hand brake and yelled to a passing motorist to bring help.

Mr. Thoebbe was the father of nine children. He made his home at 797 Highland avenue, Covington. He was born in Covington and had been in the postal service 20 years. He was a member of the National Association of Letter Carriers and held membership in the Holy Name Society of St. Augustine Church.

Besides his daughter, Lucille, he leaves his widow, Mary Louise; five other daughters, Joann, Ruth, Esther, Judy and Cathy; three sons, Carl, Neal and Bernard, and his parents, Mr. and Mrs. Bernard Toebbe.
