Crescent White Villa Team Seek Honors

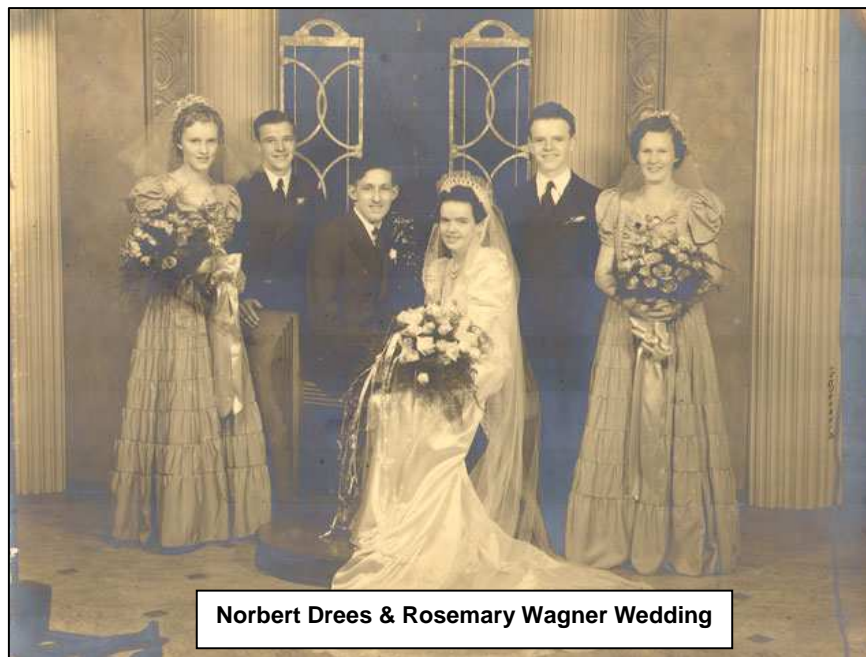
