Entered the Sisters of Notre Dame on August 22, 1893 in Cleveland, Ohio

Invested on January 2, 1894 in Cleveland

Profession of vows on August 30, 1897 in Cleveland

She was a teacher: She taught school for 53 years

Sister must have been a musician also. She has certificates in her file from Pius X School of Liturgical Music (College of the Sacred Heart, New York City) dated 1929 (same as her sister)

Sister Liguori died on March 11, 1955 at age 79. She was found dead in her room. Buried in Calvary Cemetery in Toledo, Lot 162-184, Section 25, Number 81
Another sister died while praying at Sister Liguori's coffin. Had double funeral liturgy at St. Ann Church in Toledo.
