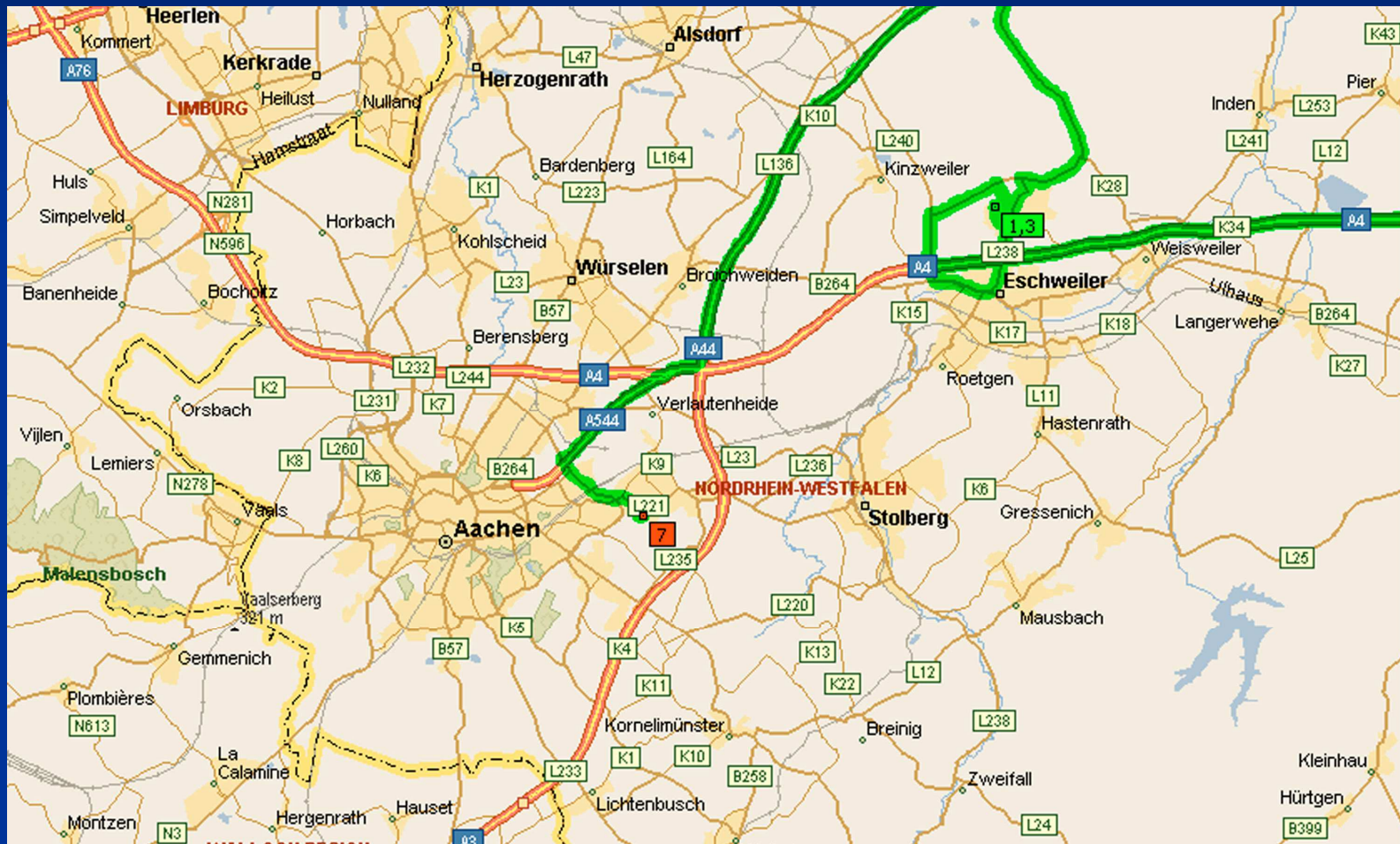

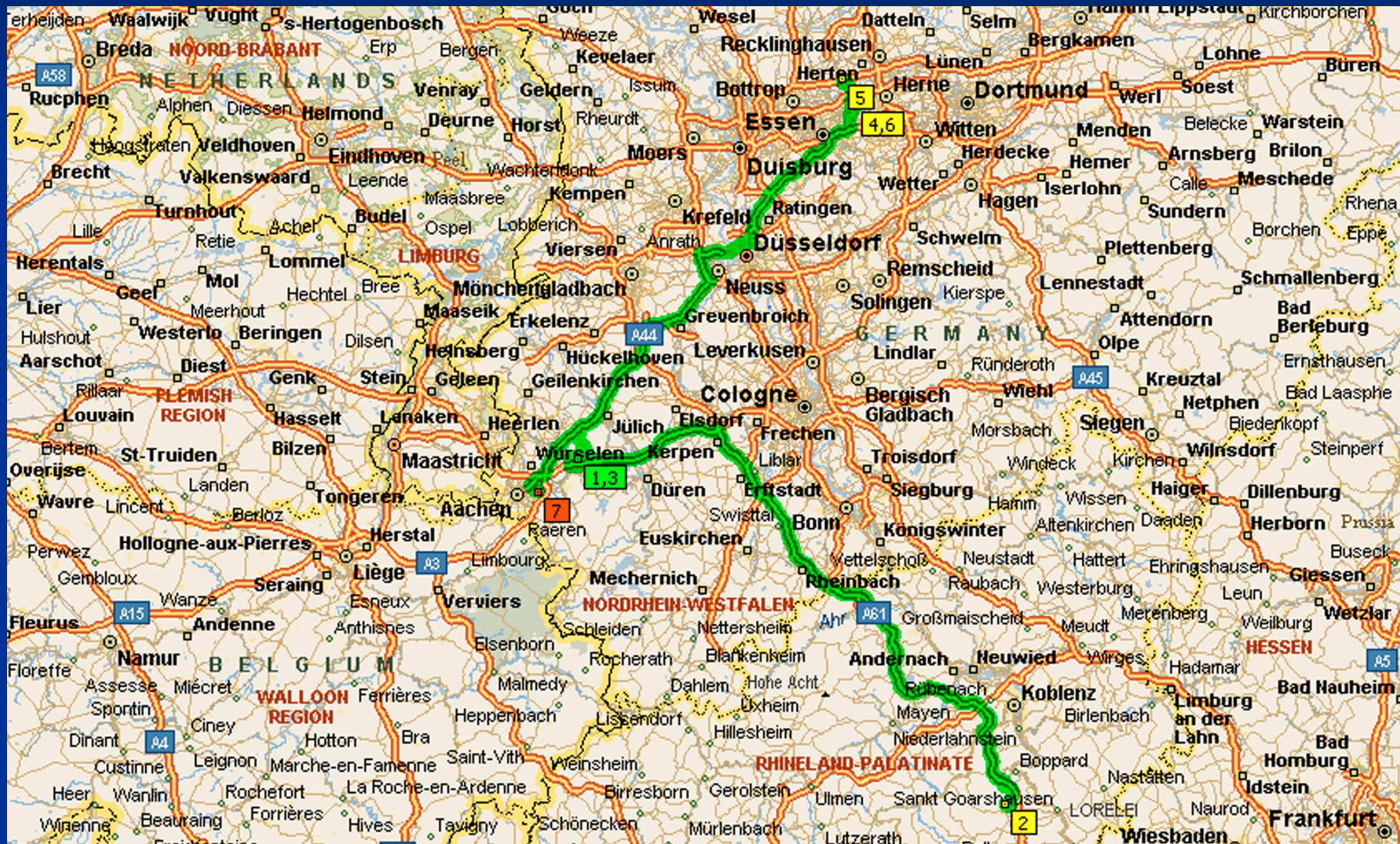

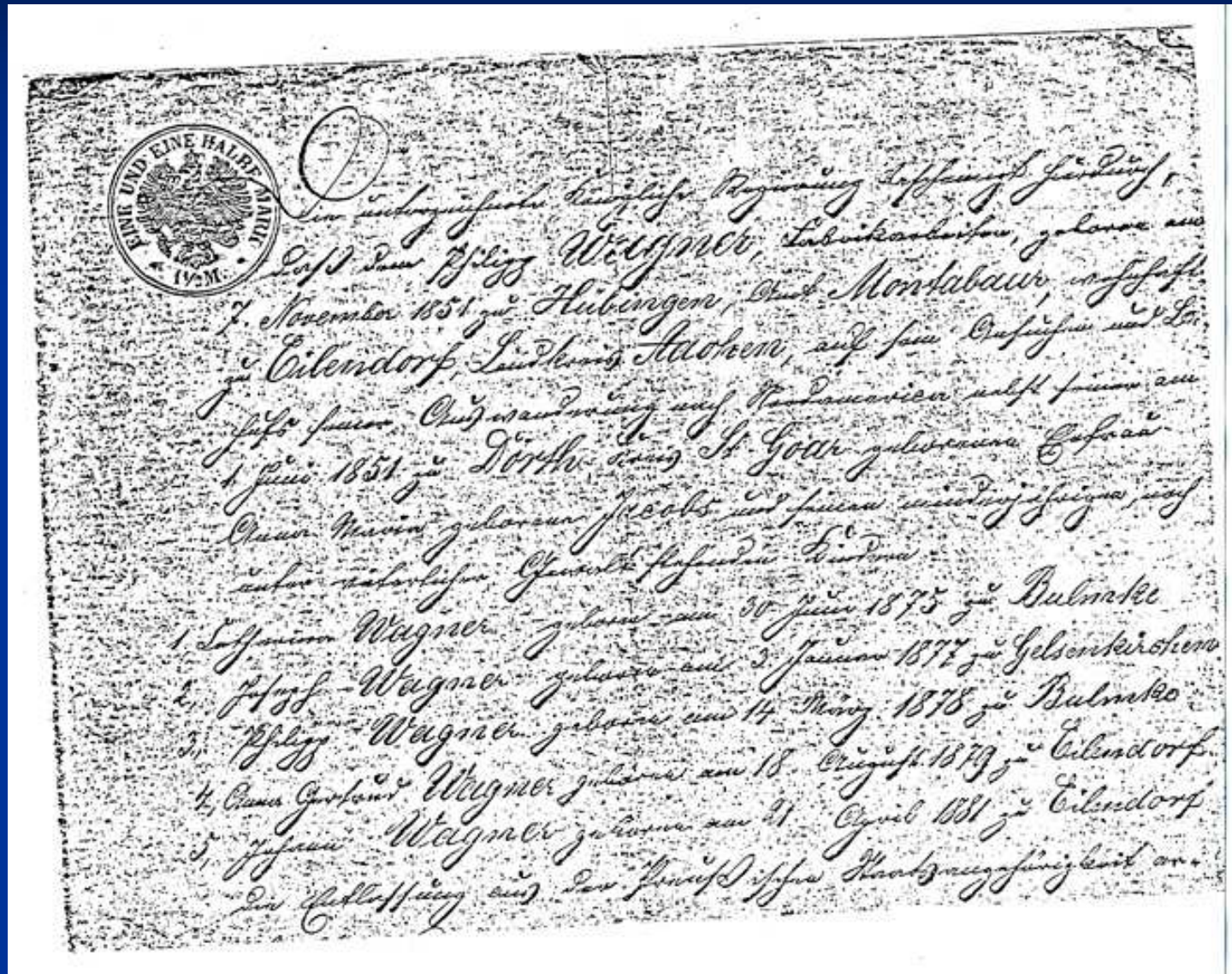

native of Germany
a free white person, and proved, to the satisfaction of the court, that he made in
the Court

more than two years ago, the requisite declaration of his intention to become a
CITIZEN OF THE UNITED STATES, and also at the same time came
L. M. Bentele Leo Bentele

and being duly sworn did depose and say that the said
Philipp Wagner has resided for five years last past, in the United
States, and he has resided one year last past in the State of Ohio, and that during
all that time he has behaved as a man of good moral character, attached to the principles
of the Constitution of the United States, and as well disposed to the good order and
happiness of the same.

And Thereupon the said Philipp Wagner
made solemn oath that he would support the Constitution of the United States, and that
he doth absolutely and entirely renounce and abjure all allegiance and fidelity to every
Foreign Prince, Potentate, State or Sovereignty, whatsoever, and particularly
all allegiance and fidelity to the German Emperor

whose subject he was.

Whereupon it is Ordered, by the Court, that a Certificate of Citizenship be issued
to him on payment of costs of this application.

Ex-Akronite Heads Navy Squadron

Former Akronite Robert H. Wagner has been named commanding officer of Patrol Squadron 18 at the U. S. Naval Station, Roosevelt Roads, Puerto Rico.

Cmdr. Wagner, who moves up from executive officer of the squadron, will serve in his new position for about a year.

He is the son of Henry T. Wagner, 91 Mt. View av., Akron, who went to Puerto Rico to witness the change of command ceremony.

CMDR. WAGNER is a graduate of the old West High School and Ohio State University, with honors. He also attended Akron U.

Appointed an aviation midshipman in 1948, he received his flight training at Pensacola, Fla. and Corpus Christi,

Tex.

For a while, he served the officer assignment section of the Bureau of Naval Personnel. In 1964, he was transferred to Patrol Squadron 21 at Brunswick, Me., where for two years he was operations officer.

BEFORE REPORTING to Puerto Rico, he attended the British Joint Services Staff College at Latimer, England. He was the only representative of U. S. Naval aviation assigned in the class of over 80 student officers representing nations from all services and every continent.

He and his wife, Evelyn, have three daughters.

He succeeded Cmdr. Austin L. Zicht, a native of Dayton, as commanding officer at the squadron in Puerto Rico.

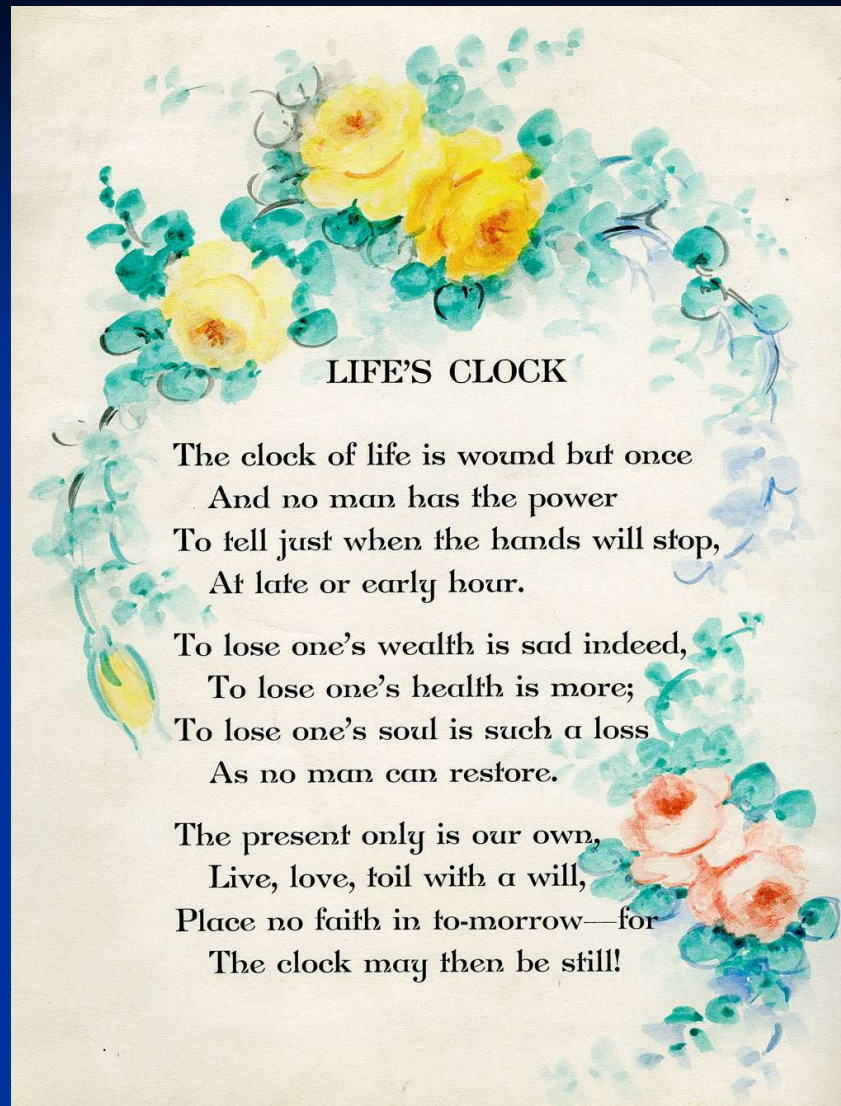
